



Request for Proposals

The California Coalition Against Sexual Assault (CALCASA) is looking for a consultant to provide services to support CALCASA in its assessment of California's Rape Prevention and Education Program, to determine progress of the capacity of California's rape crisis centers to conduct sexual violence primary prevention efforts according to the California RPE Capacity Building Plan.

This assessment will be adopted from the instrument developed for the CALCASA's 2011 RPE Capacity Assessment which integrated elements of a California Department of Public Health assessment of capacity that had been used in 2007 and 2009, and elements of National Sexual Violence Resource Center (NSVRC) survey of a nationally representative sample of local rape crisis centers as part of an assessment of rape prevention work being done across the country in 2010. The 2011 Assessment was conducted as a 25-item SurveyMonkey survey to 126 people (95% response rate.)

For the 2012 Assessment, CALCASA is looking for a consultant to refine the assessment tool, coordinate with CALCASA to collect the data, analyze the data and issue a report highlighting shifts from previous surveys and implications for increasing the capacity for primary prevention practice.

Timeline: Here is the planned timeline for the assessment.

March 31, 2012:	Issue first draft of Report
June 30, 2012:	Prepare Final Report
